English

Writing- Identify audience and purpose for writing, selecting appropriate grammar and vocabulary, using correct tenses, subject and verb agreement. Proof reading for accuracy. Write a news report about the Blitz using 5W's, reported and direct speech and expanded noun phrases.

Write a biography using 5W's, rhetorical questions and chronological order.

Speaking and Listening

Reporting journalism linked to WW2. Accurate questioning for interview techniques.

Reading Letters from a Lighthouse, Christmas Carol and Tuesday - David Wiesner. Answering questions with reference to VIPERS – termly focus vocabulary, inference and prediction.

Maths

Place Value:

Compare and round numbers to 1,000,000

Number & Calculations:

Use place value knowledge, formal written addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, factors, prime, square and cube numbers, times and divide by 10,100,1000

Fractions:

Finding equivalent fractions, compare and order, add and subtract, mixed and improper fractions

Measure: Measure and calculate the area and perimeter of shapes.

Shape/Geometry: Identify 3d Shapes, Symmetry and Reflection

Science

Earth and Space: Planets in the solar system and their movement around the sun.

Forces: Gravity, resistances (air, water and wind) and pushes/pulls.

Computing

Coding: Code breakers, deciphering codes

Word: Effective use of Word – formats, layouts, fonts etc.

EBooks: Creating children's stories

PSHE

Relationships: Online friendships, Positive and negative friendships, identities and stereotypes.
